

APPLICATION TIMELINE / ACADEMIC YEAR 2018-2019

LISZT FERENC ACADEMY OF MUSIC, BUDAPEST

15 February 2018: application deadline for students who apply for state-subsidized studies through the national application system (further information: <https://www.felvi.hu/>; <http://lfze.hu/en/application/for-eu-citizens>)

16 February 2018: application deadline for students who apply through the Stipendium Hungaricum application system (further information: <http://studyinhungary.hu/study-in-hungary/menu/stipendium-hungaricum-scholarship-programme>)

31 March 2018: application deadline for tuition-fee paying studies - full-time, non-degree and guest studies; in case of MA applications: submission deadline of preliminary credit recognition request, transcript of BA studies (further information: <http://lfze.hu/en/application>)

early May 2018: applicants are notified of their individual entrance exam dates held in the summer. Scanned copies of the invitation letters (and entry visa request letters, if necessary) are sent via email and hard copies are sent in the post to the applicants' permanent address. (Contact the International Sub-Department if you have not received a notification about the entrance examination schedule by 30 May.)

from mid-June to early July 2018: entrance examination period, live auditions are held in Budapest, Hungary

mid-July 2018: final submission deadline of missing documents for students who apply for state-subsidized and tuition-fee paying studies

mid-July 2018: final decisions about the new admissions (state-subsidized, tuition-fee paying, Stipendium Hungaricum) are made following the entrance examinations. Applicants are notified of the decisions. Scanned copies of the letter of admission (and D5 visa request letters, if necessary) are sent via email and hard copies are sent in the post to the applicants' permanent address.

1 August 2018: final submission deadline of missing documents for students who apply through the Stipendium Hungaricum application system

August 2018: in case of a successful admission, Stipendium Hungaricum applicants receive their letter of award from the Tempus Public Foundation
